How Do We Understand Paul's Teaching About Women?

1 Timothy 2:8-15

- Women should adorn themselves in respectable apparel, with modesty and self-control
- I do not permit a woman to teach or to exercise authority over a man

Gender Specific Nature of the Curse

Genesis 3:17 (8-21)

And to Adam he said,

Because you have listened to the voice of your wife and have eaten of the tree of which I commanded you, 'You shall not eat of it,' Cursed is the ground because of you; in pain you shall eat of it all the days of your life;

Masculine Assignment of Responsibility for Family

1Timothy 5:8

But if anyone does not provide for his relatives, and especially for members of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.



Masculine Assignment of Responsibility for Family

1Deuteronomy 6:6-7

And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.



Masculine Assignment of Responsibility for Family

Ephesians 5:23-24

For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior.... Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her.



How Do We Apply Paul's Instruction?
